Subject: Grant of Central Government permission for establishment of a new dental college in the name of Sree Anjaneya Institute of Dental Sciences, Modakkallur, Calicut, Kerala, from the academic session 2013-14, with an annual intake capacity of 100 admissions in BDS course - regarding

Sir,

In continuation to this Ministry's letter of even number dated 15.07.2013 on the subject cited above, I am directed to say that Dental Council of India vide its letter No. DE-22-2013/6438 dated 12.08.2013 informed that in view of the order/directions dated 6.8.2013 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in SLP(C) No(s). 22704/2013 filed by GSL Educational Society Vs. DCI and Anr., the Executive Committee of DCI recommended to the Central Government to grant its permission for establishment of new dental colleges for starting of BDS course with 100 seats at Sree Anjaneya Institute of Dental Sciences, Modakkallur, Calicut, Kerala which was earlier recommended by DCI for 50 seats, for the academic year 2013-14, after obtaining the remaining Performance Bank Guarantee of Rs. 100.00 lakhs from the applicant. Accordingly, Letter of Intent dated 21.8.2013 was issued for accepting the terms and conditions mentioned therein and for furnishing Performance Bank Guarantee of ₹ 100 lakh.

2. In response to the LOI, the Central Government has received your letter dated 23.8.2013 thereby (a) accepting the terms and conditions contained therein, and (b) furnishing the Performance Bank Guarantee No. Nil dated 11.07.2013 issued by Indian Overseas Bank, West Hill Branch, Calicut for ₹ 100 lakh.
3. In view of the above, the formal Permission of the Central Government is hereby conveyed under section 10A (4) of the Dentists (Amendment) Act, 1993 to Sree Anjaneya Medical Trust, Calicut for establishing a new dental college in the name of Sree Anjaneya Institute of Dental Sciences, Modakkallur, Calicut, Kerala with an annual admission capacity of 100 students in BDS Course for the academic session 2013-14.
4. This permission is valid for only one year and for admitting only one batch of students during the academic session 2013-14. The next batch of students will be admitted in the college only after renewal of Central Government Permission.
5. Admissions made in violation of the above condition will be treated as irregular and action under Section 10B of the Dentists (Amendment) Act, 1993 will be initiated.
